



HEALTH & SAFETY RULES

By interacting or taking part in any party pony experience it will be deemed you have accepted these terms and conditions. If you are in any doubt please ask a handler.

Our ponies' welfare is paramount. These ponies are very good-natured, but they *are* living animals with their own minds. We will do our best to ensure that the experience is as safe as possible, but we cannot guarantee a one hundred percent risk-free environment.

If the external environment becomes unsafe (as defined by the handler) for any reason including the weather, our handler reserves the right to stop the event.

Ponies can bite, kick, tread on toes and get you dirty. However, we aim to minimise the risk of any unforeseeable accident of this type.

All children must have permission from their parent or guardian to take part.

The handler reserves the right to stop the event at any time if any action or conduct is deemed inappropriate or would be to the detriment of the ponies' welfare.

The handler may need to make physical contact with the child/adult for their own (or the ponies') safety.

No abuse or cruelty towards the ponies or the handlers will be tolerated.

You must not feed the ponies.

You must wear sensible footwear.

You must inform of us of any allergies or illness that may be affected by the pony experience.

You must listen to and follow any instruction given by the handler.
